
As part of taking a Live Online Proctored test you must meet certain requirements during the check-in process before beginning. One of the check-in requirements is that you must submit a photo identification card to a live proctor for verification. We highly recommend that you capture your Photo ID card and submit it here. Your Photo ID will be saved under your account and can be viewed by the proctor during the check-in process. You may skip this ID capture step as it is not required to book your test today. If you do not submit your Photo ID today you can upload it later using the Manage tab.
